#### **Healthy Child Policy**

No sick children will be accepted into any children's ministry event. If you have any questions, please contact Pastor Gwen Leatherwood at gwen.leatherwood@summitchuchwylie.org

If a child's sickness is discovered or he/she becomes sick the guardian will be notified immediately to come check out their child from class.

### Children should remain with their parents if they have any of the following symptoms:

- 1. A fever over 100 degrees within the last 24 hours
- 2. Vomited within the last 24 hours
- 3. Unexplained rash or weeping sores
- 4. Diarrhea
- 5. Yellow, greenish, thick mucus discharge from eyes or nose
- 6. Lice

# The diapering of an infant or toddler should take place in the nursery room under the observation of another volunteer.

- Lay the child on the clean mattress pad, making sure that one hand is on the child at all times.
- Please make sure you either, wear the gloves that are provided or use hand sanitizer before changing the child's diaper.
- Change diaper and use wipes provided.
- Roll diaper up and place in the trashcan.
- Dress the child and move them to a safe place.
- Clean area with disinfecting wipes.
- Please take the trash out during clean up time at the end of your serving time.
